Origami Rose

Materials:

- 1 sheet of origami paper
 Tip: You can also recycle and use colourful magazines, catalogues or used gift wraps! Just cut them into a square.
- Double-sided tape

Did you know?

Named after the Latin word *rosa,* the rose is a flowering shrub belonging to the family Rosaceae. With over a hundred species and thousands of cultivars, its blooms vary in size and shape, and come in many different colours.

The rose hip of some species are full of vitamin C, making it the perfect ingredient for herbal teas, jams, jelly and marmalade. An oil is also extracted from the seeds, and is used widely in skincare regimes.





Origami Rose

Step 1

Fold the paper in half on each diagonal axis. Crease well and unfold.





Step 2

Fold the paper in half to form a rectangle. Crease well and unfold.






Origami Rose

Step 3

Fold the sides inwards to form a triangle.



Step 4

Fold the corners upwards. Flip over and repeat.





Step 5

Fold the tips downwards, open the flap and press down to create a square fold. Flip over and repeat.



Step 6

Fold the top down and flatten it.





Step 7

Turn the paper to the side, open the flaps and flatten them into two triangles.






Origami Rose

Step 8

Flip the paper over, lift the flap.






Origami Rose

Step 9

Open the flaps.



Twist the flaps to form a rose.





Step 11

Curl the tips with a bamboo skewer or chopstick.





Step 12

Use a double-sided tape to hold the flap down where required.
